## Chapter News . . .

*Epsilon Iota* (San Jose State University) arranged a full schedule of lectures and debates during the academic year. Departmental members participated in discussions on impeachment, taxes, and women's views of women in politics. Guest lecturers included Mayor Jerry Smith of Saratoga, Dr. Jack Staveley of Queensland University, Australia, Dean Alexander of Santa Clara Law School, Harry V. Jaffa, and Peter Grothe. Other political speakers were State Senator George Moscone, Secretary of State Jerry Brown, and Mayor Joseph Alioto of San Francisco as well as other gubernatorial candidates in California.

*Delta Psi* (Eastern Illinois University) reports many activities were held this past year. Several faculty-student picnics afforded opportunities for recreational sports and meeting faculty and student members. Dr. C. A. Hollister, pre-legal adviser at Eastern Illinois University, spoke on October 3, 1973, about constitutional rights of college students. At an initiation dinner on March 4, 1974, attended by twenty-seven new initiates, many guests including two mayors, the University president, and two presidents of local junior colleges, heard His Excellency Salem S. Al-sabah, envoy from Kuwait, speak about "Arab Oil and the World Energy Crisis." A Candidates' Day for the primary election took place in April, with a reception, refreshments, and questions and answers.

*Delta Chi* (Macalester College) initiated members on May 1. Dr. Frank Sorauf, Dean of the College of Liberal Arts was the guest lecturer.

*Beta* (University of Oklahoma) members participated in discussions on seeking employment in the State of Oklahoma. On March 6 a similar forum, also held with the geography honor society, heard a representative of the U.S. Civil Service Commission discuss opportunities for social scientists in the Federal Government. On March 18 Dr. Felix A. Nigro of the University of Georgia spoke on "The New Public Administration."

*Epsilon Omega* (Villanova University) on April 24 gave honorary membership to Joseph S. Clark, former U.S. Senator from Pennsylvania, guest speaker at the spring initiation ceremonies.

*Zeta* (Southern Methodist University) held a fall initiation ceremony on October 19, 1973, with Professor Rowland Egger speaking on "American Political Science: Reflections on the Evolution of the Discipline during the Past Fifty years." The spring initiation on April 9 preceded a speech by Professor Fred R. von der Mehden, Albert Thomas Professor of Political Science at Rice University, entitled "Comparative Politics and Area Studies: Challenges and Problems of Research."

*Zeta Gamma* (East Texas State University) held a spring initiation banquet, April 1, with Professor Harvey Mansfield, Jr., Chairman of the Department of Government at Harvard University, as guest speaker. His topic was "Reflections on the Study of Politics." James D. Cole, member of the Texas House of Representatives, received the Good Government Award, given annually by the chapter. A new award established this year for Teacher Excellence went to Dr. Charles P. Elliott, Jr., of the Department of Political Science, East Texas State.
